They have achieved this through various innovative approaches, such as helping disadvantaged women in India, supporting children living in poverty in Guatemala, hosting free market seminars and discussions throughout Latin America, along with many other initiatives.

Due to high demand for LOLA this year, we have made several useful changes. This includes assigning a Regional Leader to each of our six regions. These Regional Leaders are focusing on the specific needs of their region and providing the tailored support to Chapter leaders and members. This ensures that they receive on-the-ground help from a leader who is familiar with the social, economic, and political climate of each region. Furthermore, we have expanded our communications and Chapter Programs teams to enhance our digital efforts and provide leaders with the necessary support to continue promoting libertarian ideas.

Looking ahead to 2024, LOLA has exciting new projects launching. These projects aim to connect new audiences to our ideas and train leaders, advocates, and activists to become more effective ambassadors of liberty.

Once again, we extend our heartfelt gratitude to everyone who played a role in our 2023 journey. As the demand for LOLA grows, we are confident that with your continued support, 2024 will be another record year for LOLA.

1) LOLA Chapter Program

LOLA Social Chapters are ladies only social groups located in cities throughout the globe where like-minded women can come together to share their passion for libertarian ideas, establish a strong community through relationship building, and advance their skills as leaders, activists, and advocates of liberty. LOLA welcomes women from various life stages, from students to retirees, as we build a community of women actively engaged in libertarian ideas. Events range from free market workshops, policy discussions, self-defense classes, happy hours, and many more.

2) LOLA Leadership Training

We provide leaders with the leadership and knowledge they need to reach new audiences through our Regional Leadership Retreats. Previous training topics include political activism, writing op-eds, on-camera media training, personal branding, public speaking, chapter outreach and engagement and more. LOLA provides skills-based training to help women reach their personal and professional goals and become the best ambassadors of liberty able to reach new audiences.

3) LOLA Speakers Bureau

LOLA provides an invaluable tool to media producers, event organizers, and LOLA Chapter Leaders by offering a searchable database of over 100 female leaders dedicated to the ideas of liberty, available to speak throughout the globe on a variety of topics.




